*SUPERVISED & MENTORED CLINIC –

A total of **50 hours Supervised Clinic + 150 hours of Mentored Clinic** is required for Level 4. To join the AKA as a Level 4, Kinesiology Intermediate Practitioner in the first instance a minimum of 20 hours of Supervised Clinic & 30 hours of Mentored clinic must be completed. Followed by a minimum of 40 hours of Supervised & Mentored clinic per annum until the required 200 hours is reached (i.e. **50 hours Supervised Clinic + 150 hours of Mentored Clinic**).
