DISTINGUISHED PROFESSOR JON ADAMS

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GROWING EVIDENCE AND RESEARCH CAPACITY IN KINESIOLOGY

Despite some pockets of excellence, the evidence base and research capacity in Kinesiology remains heavily underdeveloped. It is also critical that contemporary initiatives in Kinesiology research are practice-based, practice-relevant and practice-benefitting and that research questions and their address reflect the daily routine care and experiences of Kinesiologists and their clients.

In this presentation, Distinguished Professor Jon Adams will outline a number of research initiatives directly designed to help grow an evidence-base and research capacity in Kinesiology in Australia. Jon will explore how these initiatives can help produce a rigorous, critical and sustainable research culture which can help build a strong research platform and infrastructure for kinesiology research.

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Jon is Distinguished Professor of Public Health, UTS conducting research in traditional, complementary, integrative and primary healthcare. He is a Fulbright Senior Scholar; ARC Professorial Future Fellow; Director, Australian Research Centre in Complementary & Integrative Medicine (ARCCIM), UTS; Senior Fellow, Oxford International Primary Care Research Leadership Program, University of Oxford; National Convenor of PHAA CM SIG; and International Membership Chair, ICTHP at APHA.

Jon has attracted >\$20M in competitive funding incl. 16 NHMRC/ARC grants & >\$10M industry funds. Jon is Editor of 9 research books (Palgrave, Imperial College Press[2], Routledge[4], Ashgate, Elsevier), has an H-Index of 47 and an i-10 of 230. Jon is currently focused on mentorship, implementation and PBRN designs.
